"Summer Fun" is a program hosted by the South East Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO; www.vnseameo.org). This experiential teaching and learning program helps children in Vietnam improve their English skills through a fun learning environment with native English speakers. **Education and TESOL majors preferred.**

The internship includes:

- Four-week internship in July 2013.
- Co-teaching 16–20 hours a week to students ages 5–15.
- Room and board, plus a daily stipend of \$10-15.
- Partial subsidy for round-trip air travel from NYC to Vietnam.
- Guided tours with travel opportunities, such as tours of Ho Chi Minh City, the Cao Dai temples, the Cu Chi tunnel, Mekong Delta, Dalat, and Nha Trang, as well as a shopping tour.

This highly competitive internship program with four to six openings is available to all QC undergraduate and graduate students. **Applications will be accepted December 5–28.** Interns will be selected in January. To apply, visit:
