Today's dynamic business environment requires analytical thinking, fact-based decision making and collaborative action. You'll experience it all firsthand in *Challenge*, our campus case competition. The *Challenge* case competition models real-world business scenarios focusing on the strategic issues currently being faced by companies all over the world. It is open to all freshmen, sophomores and juniors (in a five-year program) and does not require detailed knowledge of business concepts or accounting.

Within a designated period of time, small teams of students work together to review a business case, develop a solution and create a presentation. They then deliver their solution to a group of PwC professionals. Success is measured by three key criteria: critical thinking, collaboration and communication. Participants walk away with valuable insights into our profession, our firm, and the issues faced by global business leaders.


