The Center for Fiction is the only nonprofit literary organization in the U.S. solely dedicated to celebrating fiction. In February 2019, we opened the doors to our new building in Downtown Brooklyn, creating a home for NYC's literary community.

We're known for our [special literary events](#), including our innovative panels, performances, lectures, and conversations, and we need interns to help them run smoothly. We are seeking people who are passionate about the literary world and who want to participate as a team to ensure the programs here are of the highest possible quality for all involved. Shifts are mostly evenings, from 5 until 9 pm, with occasional openings for daytime KidsRead events.

Duties include:
