The “Joe Crowley for Congress” campaign is looking for motivated and enthusiastic students to join our team. This is an ideal opportunity to gain experience in grassroots organizing and learn about the democratic process, on a campaign for one of the most influential Democratic members in the United States House of Representatives.

Through active participation in the political process, team members will get an inside view of a political campaign. Interns will develop and use creative and analytical thinking, possess strong oral and written communication skills, and display initiative and determination.

Interns are expected to handle a wide variety of projects and responsibilities such as:

- Interacting with residents in the 14th Congressional District
- Assist in grass-roots organizing within local areas.
- Identifying and attending community events
- Communicating with residents about Joe’s record in Queens & the Bronx
- Participating and organizing campaign events and rallies
- Interacting with staff and providing recommendations based on canvassing and phone banking

Requirement:

Interns are asked to participate in at least 10 hours a week. However, a commitment of 20 hours is recommended in order to gain the broadest experience from the internship program.
