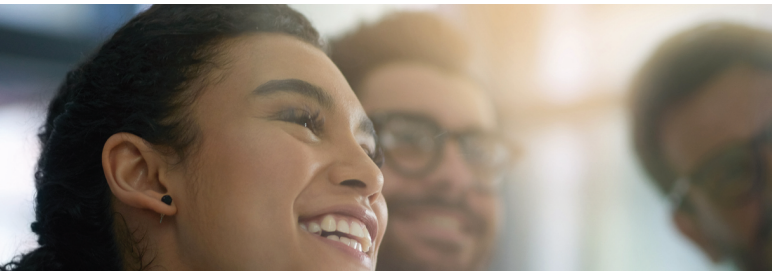


2019 Credit Suisse Women's Mentor Program
