## About the InterExchange Program

The InterExchange Work & Travel Ireland program lets you travel for a few months, or as long as one year in Ireland on a Working Holiday Authorization. This gives you the ability to work and earn money to fund your travels. Common places of employment are restaurants, cafes, hotels, bars and offices in Dublin or Galway. Career specific work can also be pursued, but jobs are generally seasonal. You'll have support with your job search and logistics.

Friendly, Dublin-based staff members are available to discuss your goals for working and provide support for finding jobs, help with logistics, and social activities. You'll have access to a support and resource center throughout your time in Ireland.

## Orientation

The program includes pre-departure advising and an orientation meeting in Dublin within your first week covering safety, logistics, the job market, traveling, taxes and more. Orientations take place year-round so you can arrive any time.
