- Explore the legacy of the Holocaust in Poland, its effects on collective memory, and complexities surrounding such categories as victim, bystander, and perpetrator.
- Beginning in New York, then traveling to Krakow, Warsaw, Łódź, Treblinka, Oświęcim (Auschwitz), and small towns.
- Take part in an intensive program at the Auschwitz-Birkenau State Museum.
