

# **MA and MS.Ed/English Preregistration Summer and Fall 2012**

## **Monday April 16 / Tuesday April 17 / Wednesday April 18**

Preregistration for MA English summer and fall classes will take place the week following spring break, from Monday April 16 to Wednesday April 18.

Course descriptions are posted on the department bulletin board and on the English Department website. I'm also attaching copies of all course information and descriptions to this listserve announcement.

## **Instructions**

- You can preregister for up to 2 summer and up to 3 fall MA courses.
- Preregistration hours are listed at the bottom of this announcement. If any of the following statements apply to you, then you must meet in person with a graduate program director in order to preregister for classes:
  1. You have outstanding incompletes from previous semesters
  2. You have exceeded the four-year "time to degree" limit set by the College and need to file an extension with the Dean of Graduate Studies
  3. You wish to preregister for English 791, the thesis writing class.
  4. You wish to preregister for English 792, the 1-credit thesis writing workshop that serves as an extension of English 791
  5. You wish to preregister for English 795, an independent study elective with a faculty member

NOTE: English 791 and 792 (the thesis writing electives) and English 795 (the independent study elective) are not available during the two summer sessions, only during the fall semester.

- If none of these five statements applies to you, then you may also email you preregistration choices to Andrea Walkden ([andrea.walkden@qc.cuny.edu](mailto:andrea.walkden@qc.cuny.edu)) or Wayne Moreland ([waphalpa@aol.com](mailto:waphalpa@aol.com)) and we will enter them into CUNYfirst by the end of the preregistration period. Once your preregistration choices have been entered, you will receive a confirmation email asking you to check the details of your registration on CUNYfirst. Email preregistration requests will be handled in the order in which they are received. Your email must be sent by 7:00pm on Wednesday April 18 and contain:

1. Your full name as it appears on CUNYfirst

2. Your eight-digit CUNY or student ID number  
(Please don't send us your Social Security number. If you don't know your CUNY ID number, simply say so and we will supply it for you.)
3. The course number, course instructor, and 4-digit course code for each of your pre-registration choices. For example:  
English 636 (code 1297): "What is literature? What is literary theory."
