

NUTRITION THERAPY CONCENTRATION

The Nutrition Therapy concentration is for anyone interested in pursuing the clinical side of the nutrition industry or wanting to explore multiple career paths related to nutrition and dietetics.

Throughout the 15 month program, you'll complete clinical, community, and foodservice site rotations alongside dietetic and elective graduate courses to earn your MS in Nutrition and Dietetics with a Nutrition Therapy emphasis and be eligible to sit for the Registered Dietitian exam.

SITES
