Throughout the 15 month program, you'll complete culinary-specific and clinical site rotations alongside dietetic and business graduate courses to earn your MS in Nutrition and Dietetics with a Culinary Entrepreneurship emphasis and be eligible to sit for the Registered Dietitian exam.
