Mission Statement

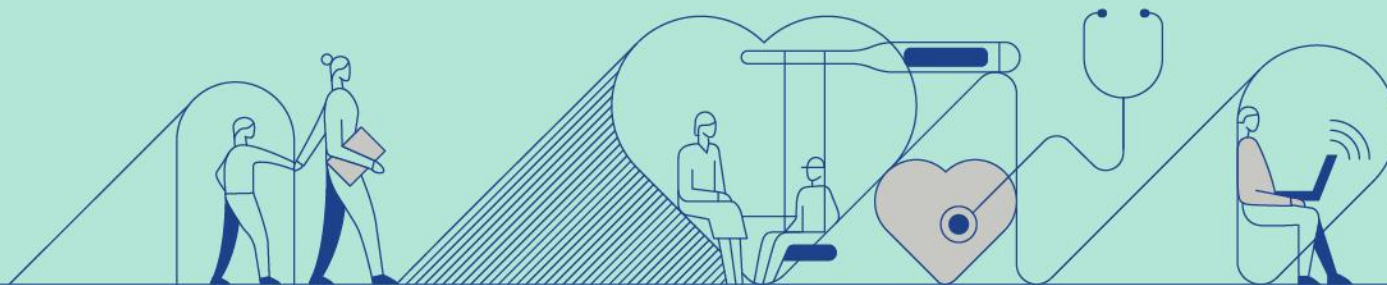

Selection Criteria

- ✓ Graduate of an Accredited program with a valid DPD verification statement
- ✓ Completed Master's degree or verification that a Master's degree will be completed within 150% of program length (12 months from the start of the DI). Master's degree can be in any field and with any educational institution.
- ✓ Overall GPA 3.0
- ✓ Excellent references (at least 1 academic)
- ✓ GRE not required
- ✓ Paid or volunteer experience as it applies to nutrition or food service
- ✓ Solid written, interpersonal and leadership skills
- ✓ Top applicants will be asked to interview via Microsoft Teams

<u>July 24, 2023</u>	DICAS Application portal opens for all program directors. The DICAS application is open to any supervised practice program (DI, CP, GP, ISPP) to accept applications.	DICAS Application opens to allow applicants to begin their application on https://dicas.liaisoncas.com DICAS application fee for the first designation is \$50 and \$25 for each additional designation.
<u>December 1, 2023</u>		D&D Digital opens to allow applicants to register on their website at www.dnndigital.com . D&D registration fee is \$65. Only Dietetic Internships participate in the computer match process and use D&D Digital to match to their applicants.
<u>February 1, 2024</u>	Deadline date for those programs participating in the preselect option for the computer match to have notified applicants of acceptance to the program. The list of applicants preselected must be e-mailed to D&D Digital (Info@dnndigital.com) also on this date.	
<u>February 15, 2024</u> Deadline for Registering for Computer Match and Entering Internship Preferences		Applicants must register online at www.dnndigital.com , pay the computer match fee by credit card and enter their contact information and Dietetic Internship preferences by 11:59 pm Central Time February 15, 2024.
<u>February 15, 2024</u> Deadline for Completing DICAS Application		DICAS Application Portal will close for Dietetic Internship Programs. Applications to Dietetic Internship Programs must be submitted by 11:59 pm Central Time on February 15, 2024.

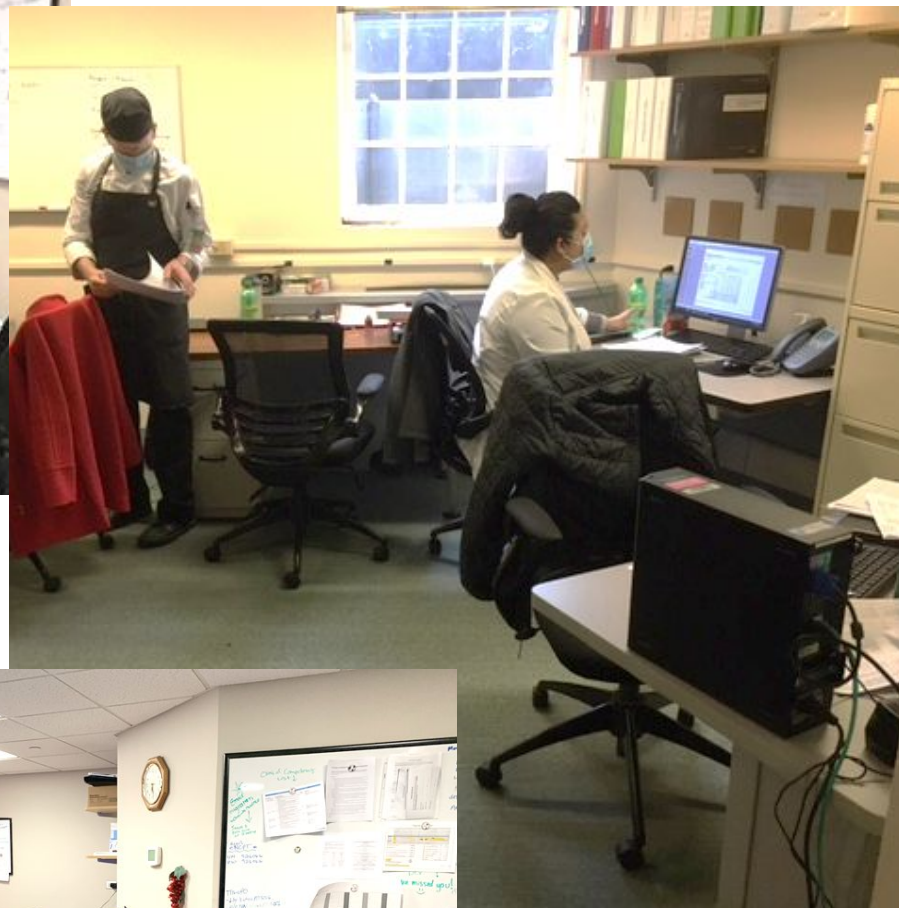
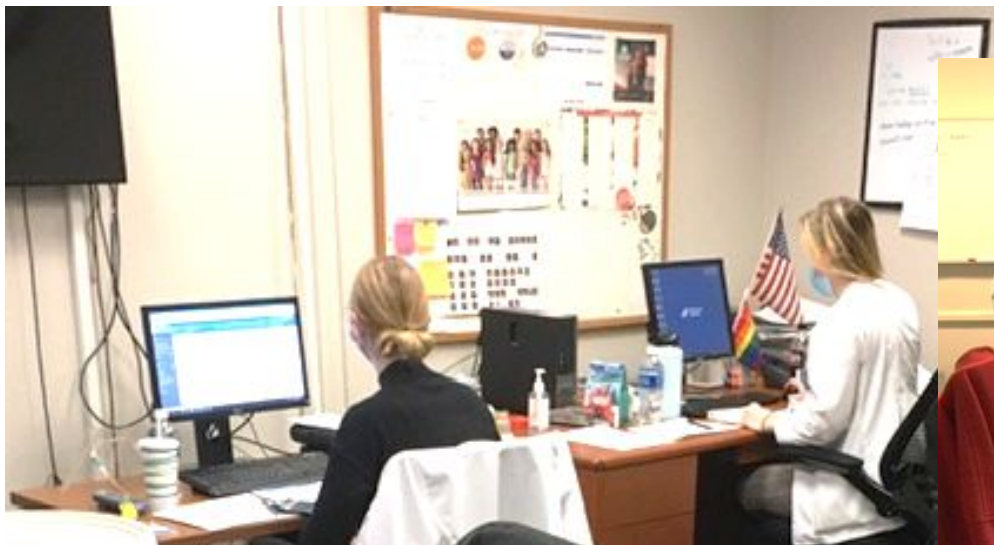

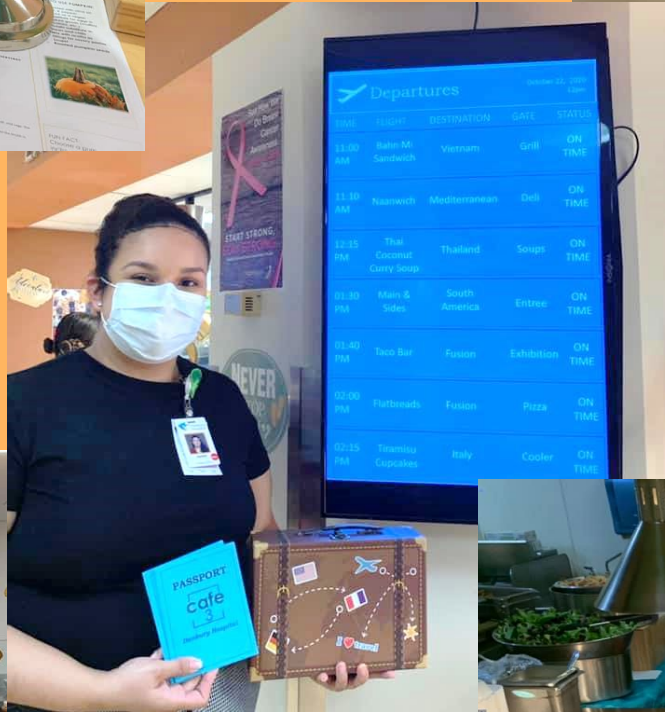
