Rules & Regulations

All participants must be active or new members in an active fraternity or sorority at CUNY Queens College.

Participants must be listed on the chapter roster in order to participate. Organizations may invite members at other schools to participate but you must email Nicole Pantano at Nicole.Pantano55@gmail.cuny.edu 24 hours in advance.

There will be no drugs or alcohol present at any Fall Brawl Event.

Please remember CUNY Queens College is a “dry” campus. If any member of your organization is suspected of being under the influence will be penalized and disqualified from participating in any activities for that scheduled day, or the entire week.

All events begin promptly and at scheduled time. It is important for your organization to arrive at scheduled time. The Secretary will take attendance at the beginning and end of every event. If an organization must miss an event or will not have quorum there make sure to contact Nicole 24 hours in advance for excusal, with legitimate excuse as to why they will not be attending the event.

Cancellation or postponement due to weather conditions is at the discretion of the Inter Greek Council. Notice of such cancellation or postponements will be made accessible to entity

presidents via email the morning of the event by the Programming Chair. If no notice is given organizations must assume events will still occur at due scheduled time.

Please be advised that all Greek Week Events require a half plus one requirement of quorum participation within your organization.

Philanthropy Project

The Philanthropy we will be donating money to is Community Service Made Easy. They are a Non Profit that donates money to Children in hospitals such as St. Mary's and Jamaica Hospital. The money raised during Penny Wars and our Bake Sale/Fundraiser will be donated there. As well as the money raised, we will also be doing a craft that allows us to decorate sun catchers and paintings that will be given to children in hospitals to decorate their rooms. Any donations besides what we raise will be helpful!

Breakdown of Events

Bake Sale/Fundraiser: We will be having a bake sale fundraiser in the President's Lounge to raise money for the week's philanthropies. We ask each organization to bring in something to sell at the bake sale! Whether it be a tray of cookies, cupcakes or brownies!

Sorority Bonding Night: This night is for sorority members only. It will be a karaoke night in the President's Lounge with snacks. It is a time for the sororities on Queens College Campus to get to know each other more and bond.

Community Service Arts & Crafts: Community Service Made Easy will supply us with sun catchers to paint and decorate. After we decorate them they will be donated to Children's hospitals to brighten up their rooms.

Fraternity Bonding Night: This night is for fraternity members only. It will be an activity night in the patio room. Snacks will be provided and it will be a time to get to know each other on campus.

Penny Wars: It is a week-long challenge. There will be 12 jars set up in the Student Association Lounge, (courtesy of Beatriz and Carmine) Each jar will have an organization on it. The objective of penny wars is to donate PENNIES ONLY into your organization's jar to raise money. However, the "war" part of it is that you can try and sabotage the other teams by putting silver coins (nickels, dimes, quarters, half dollars, dollar coins) in their jar. Each penny is worth +1 point; each silver coin is -5 points. At the end of the week the coins will be added up and the organization with the most points win. The

main goal of the weeklong event is to raise money with a little friendly competition.
