

Student Affairs Awards

2017 CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Burton L. Backner Student Affairs Award \$500

Awarded to a student who demonstrates outstanding overall commitment to student affairs and student services on campus.

- Must be registered as a full-time undergraduate student.
- Minimum GPA of 3.5.
- Minimum of 100 credits completed.

Student Life Award \$300

Awarded to a student who demonstrates outstanding overall commitment and service to student life on campus, including student clubs/organizations, student programming, student government, etc.

- Must be registered as a full-time undergraduate student.
- Minimum GPA of 2.5.
- Minimum of 100 credits completed.

Gender, Race & Culture Award \$300

Awarded to a student who demonstrates outstanding commitment to understanding, appreciating, and promoting issues of gender, race, and culture as they relate to student life on campus.

- Must be registered as a full-time student.
- Minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Minimum of 30 credits completed for undergraduate applicant; 9 credits for graduate applicant.

Peace Award \$300

Awarded to a student who must be a member of a student club or organization and has significantly contributed to the peaceful resolution of on-campus issues related to gender, race, culture, and/or sexual orientation.

- Must be registered as a full-time student.
- Minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Minimum of 30 credits completed for undergraduate applicant; 9 credits for graduate applicant.
- Application must be completed jointly by the applicant and the president/chair of the student club/organization.

Humanitarian Award \$300

Awarded to a student who demonstrates outstanding commitment to local, state, federal, and/or international humanitarian efforts.

- Must be registered as a full-time student.
- Minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Minimum of 30 credits completed for undergraduate applicant; 9 credits for graduate applicant.
- At least one letter of recommendation must be submitted from the chair/president of a humanitarian organization.

Community Service Award \$300

Awarded to a student who demonstrates outstanding commitment to a local community service organization dedicated to improving the lives of underprivileged or disadvantaged New Yorkers.

- Must be registered as a full-time student.
- Minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Minimum of 30 credits completed for undergraduate applicant; 9 credits for graduate applicant.
- At least one letter of recommendation must be submitted from the chair/president of the community service organization.
