Visit **Johannesburg** and **Soweto**, and go on a safari in **Kruger National Park**, one of the largest game reserves in Africa. Travel to **Cape Town**, the **Cape Peninsula**, **Table Mountain National Park**, **Robben Island**, and the country's fine vineyards. Learn about South Africa from Queens College faculty experts and knowledgeable guides.

This 11-day tour begins in **Johannesburg** and ends in **Cape Town**. The estimated cost of the trip is \$3,600.00.† The tour is capped at 20 people. Actual cost per person depends on the total number of travelers and is based on double occupancy; single supplements are available at additional cost. The cost includes some meals, but does not include gratuities, visas, passport fees, or international flights.
