Though a grant from the **Parkinson Voice Project**, Queens College's **Speech-Language-Hearing-Center** is excited to offer this new program for people with Parkinson's disease to work on their speech and communications skills:



During SPEAK OUT!®, clients with Parkinson's receive individual therapy and practice **speaking with intent** with a speech-language pathologist (SLP) through a series of speech, voice and cognitive exercises.



Upon completion, clients graduate to The LOUD Crowd® — weekly group sessions that reinforce the SPEAK OUT!® exercises and provide accountability, camaraderie, education, and support.
