

to help, thanks to
new rules.**



SNAP provides monthly benefits on a debit card that you can use to buy food at grocery stores. **Many more students may now be eligible.**

Low-income students between the ages of 18 and 49 who are enrolled at least half-time in higher education may be eligible if they meet any of the following:

- Qualify to participate in a work-study
- Have an expected family contribution (EFC) of \$0
- Attend a SUNY/CUNY community college, comprehensive college, or technical college and are enrolled in a career and technical education (CTE) program
- Attend an Educational Opportunity Center (EOC) and are enrolled in a career and technical education (CTE) program, remedial courses, basic adult education, literacy, or English as a second language
- Can meet other SNAP rules

Contact your school's Office of the Registrar (SUNY/CUNY) or Perkins Officer (EOC) for a verification form before applying.
