

CUNY Service Corps Summer

Student - Frequently Asked Questions:

What is CUNY Service Corps Summer?

CUNY Service Corps Summer is a 5-week paid internship program funded by the Hearst Foundation specifically for CUNY matriculated students. CUNY matriculated students are defined as those enrolled in a degree program.

What are the program dates for Service Corps Summer?

The CUNY Service Corps Summer program will start on July 13th and end on August 14th.

Who is eligible for CUNY Service Corps Summer?

To be eligible for CUNY Service Corps Summer, you must be a NYC Resident, eligible to work in the US, financial aid eligible, have a minimum 2.0 GPA, and be a CUNY matriculated student. Students must demonstrate interest in service and volunteerism.

What type of internships are available?

CUNY Service Corps Summer interns will be placed in organizations from a selection of various industries that closely align with their future career goals.

How will I be selected, and how will I be notified if I am selected to participate?

CUNY Service Corps Summer staff will review applications to determine eligibility. Accepted students will be notified via email.

How much does CUNY Service Corps Summer Pay?

CUNY Service Corps Summer Interns will earn \$15/hour for 10 hours a week, during the 5-week program.

How will I be paid?

CUNY Service Corps Summer Interns will have the option to be paid via Direct Deposit or by paper check.

Can I work weekends, overtime, or past the dates of the program?

Students are allowed to intern on weekends depending on their placement. The total hours worked cannot exceed 10 hours per week. Any additional hours worked will be considered voluntary unless supplemented by an employer. Please speak to your worksite supervisor before working overtime hours.
