GILMAN INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Gilman Study Abroad Scholarship</u></p> <p>The Gilman Program enables students to study or intern abroad, providing them with skills critical to our national security and economic prosperity. This program provides funding for your study abroad experience. Women's Forum of NY Award

The award recognizes extraordinary women (**at least 25 years old or older**) and often heroic effort in overcoming adversity as they restructure their lives for success. The \$10,000 award goes directly to the recipient for whatever needs loom largest for her, whether tuition, childcare, medical bills, elder care, transportation, housing, or any other priority.

Udall Scholarship

The Scholarship Program identifies future leaders in conservation or environmental studies; or Tribal public policy and health care fields. The Udall Scholarship provides access to the Udall Alumni Network, the Scholar Orientation and a scholarship for academic expenses.

Davis-Putter Scholarship

Provides financial support for students who are active and emerging organizers in progressive movements for liberation, self-determination and social and economic justice in their communities.

Freeman-Asia Study Abroad Scholarship

Freeman Awards for Study in Asia (Freeman-ASIA) provides scholarships for U.S. undergraduate students with demonstrated financial need to study abroad in East or Southeast Asia.

Jonas E Salk Scholarship - CUNY

The Jonas Salk Scholarships are awarded annually to eight graduates of CUNY senior colleges who have been accepted by, and plan to attend, U.S. medical or graduate schools. The awards are based on academic performance, especially scientific research that the students have conducted as undergraduates. Must apply through the QC pre-med office.

Earl Warren Legal Scholarship

Earl Warren Scholarships are awarded annually to rising law students whose commitment to racial justice reveal outstanding potential for training as civil rights and public interest attorneys. Eligible law students include those entering their first or second year of full-time legal study at an accredited law school.
