RESPONSIBILITIES FOR GRANT WINNERS:

- Under the guidance of classroom teachers, share your language and culture with Spanish students in the K–12 and Foreign Language Schools throughout Spain.
- Conduct conversation lessons and participate in extracurricular activities such as workshops, school trips, music and theater events, and sporting events.
- Grantees are expected to have a weekly schedule of 12–16 hours.

In addition, each grant winner will receive a monthly allowance, an orientation course at the beginning of the year, and ongoing support, plus full medical insurance and an official certificate of program participation.

Open to students from all majors who have successfully completed at least four semesters of college coursework and have at least an intermediate level of Spanish. Recent graduates also are encouraged to apply.

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
