
## Director's Note




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# Connect Your Students to Writing Support



## I. Visit our Website

Head to [qc.cuny.edu/academics/wc](http://qc.cuny.edu/academics/wc). Click the “Login or Create an Appointment” button to access our online scheduling platform (or register for an account if it’s your first time).

## 2. Create Appointments

Once logged in, select any blank box to book. Fill out the requested information, select between an **in-person** or **online** modality, and click “Create Appointment”.
