

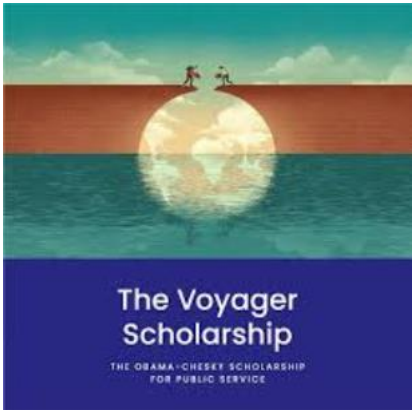

	<u>Gilman Study Abroad Scholarship</u> The Gilman Program enables students to study or intern abroad, providing them with skills critical to our national security and economic prosperity. This program provides funding for your study abroad experience. To be eligible for the Gilman Program, applicants must be receiving a Federal Pell Grant during the time of application or provide proof that they will be receiving a Pell Grant. Who: Undergraduates Deadline: March 5th
	<u>St. George's Society of NY Scholarship</u> A scholarship recognizing immigrants or the children of immigrants from British Commonwealth Countries (India, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Guyana, Jamaica, South Africa, and over 40 more – see the application for the full list.) Scholarship is for your senior year. Who: Rising Seniors Deadline: May 12th
	<u>Reducetarian Fellowship</u> A unique opportunity for students to begin building the knowledge and skills needed to make a tangible impact on our global food system. Through the program, Fellows will get: Direct access to movement leaders; Exposure to a wide range of approaches to improving the food system; Workshops and trainings; mentorship; and a 10-week paid summer residency at an impactful partner organization.

	<u>Davis-Putter Scholarship</u> Provides financial support for students who are active and emerging organizers in progressive movements for liberation, self-determination and social and economic justice in their communities. Who: All continuing students Deadline: April 1st
	<u>Freeman-Asia Study Abroad Scholarship</u> Freeman Awards for Study in Asia (Freeman-ASIA) provides scholarships for U.S. undergraduate students with demonstrated financial need to study abroad in East or Southeast Asia. Who: Undergraduates Deadline: April 7th
	<u>Jonas E Salk Scholarship - CUNY</u> The Jonas Salk Scholarships are awarded annually to eight graduates of CUNY senior colleges who have been accepted by, and plan to attend, U.S. medical or graduate schools. The awards are based on academic performance, especially scientific research that the students have conducted as undergraduates. Must apply through the QC pre-med office. Who: Seniors
	<u>The Obama-Chesky Scholarship for Public Service</u> Also known as the Voyager Scholarship, supports students who have a passion for helping others, experience serving their communities, and can demonstrate an expansive view of what's possible through public service. Includes leadership development, mentoring, financial support, travel stipends, and more. Who: Sophomores Deadline: April 1st



Earl Warren Legal Scholarship

Earl Warren Scholarships are awarded annually to rising law students whose commitment to racial justice reveal outstanding potential for training as civil rights and public interest attorneys. Eligible law students include those entering their first or second year of full-time legal study at an accredited law school.
