	<p><u>Jacqueline Schiller Scholarship - CUNY</u></p> <p>Provides scholarships to CUNY students in the fields of literature and/or history (this includes English, creative writing, ethnic studies, journalism, languages, and art history), who are among the best and brightest and who demonstrate financial need.</p> <p>Who: Continuing Students (Undergrad & Grad)</p> <p>Deadline: July 15th</p>
	<p><u>AAA Northeast Scholarship - CUNY</u></p> <p>Provides scholarships to CUNY students. This opportunity is open to matriculating students at the Associate, Baccalaureate, Master's and Doctoral levels who are registered for Fall 2025 at a CUNY college. Last Mile Scholarship - CUNY

Provides CUNY students with a one-time scholarship towards the full cost of attendance. This opportunity is open to matriculating Junior or Senior students pursuing a Bachelor's degree. Students must be enrolled in a degree focused on the field of forensics, and its subfields including psychology, financial accounting, science and/or computer and technology.

Jonas E Salk Scholarship - CUNY

The Jonas Salk Scholarships are awarded annually to eight graduates of CUNY senior colleges who have been accepted by, and plan to attend, U.S. medical or graduate schools. The awards are based on academic performance, especially scientific research that the students have conducted as undergraduates. Must apply through the QC pre-med office.

Deadline: September

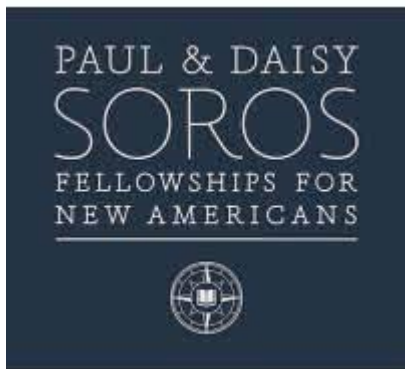


Luce Scholars
